- If you keep dismissing as not being wrong eventually it will seem right.
- If you make it a habit of always believing and never questioning yourself, you will always think you are right.
- Thinking something is right for a long time can often lead you to believe that it's right.
- A habit of wrong becomes "right."
- If you let wrong things slide for too long, your conscience will stop telling you it's wrong.

Steps to create a thesis statement:

1. Determine your essays intent. Will it inform, describe, or persuade?
2. Narrow your focus for your topic.
3. Develop a two-part statement. In part one, state or narrow your focus. In part two, add details concerning what you want to say about it (your three-parts that go along with your body paragraphs).

What is this thesis doing well?

What does this thesis need to do to improve?
